What's the problem with palm oil?

Rainforests are destroyed to make room for unsustainable palm oil plantations, which negatively affect animals, like jaguars.

Purchase products that contain sustainable palm oil, which has a minimal impact on wildlife. Find products that contain sustainable palm oil by downloading the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo shopping app. Many food items are also marked as “Rainforest Alliance Certified.”
